We are looking for an enthusiastic Project Support Intern to join the dynamic Finance, People and Governance at London Sport.

This is a varied and exciting role that will develop your knowledge, skills and experience by working across a range of London Sport projects and work areas., You will engage with teams across London Sport supporting on projects, events and office management operations.

What you'll do:

- You will work with Project Managers and other colleagues to deliver London Sport projects
- You will collect and collate monitoring and evaluation data for projects and programmes.
- You will identify, document, share and promote good practice of London Sport's projects and programmes.
- You will work with colleagues to contribute to the development, review, implementation and maintenance of good governance structures. This could involve working on grant giving projects, reviewing contracts or supporting our Board of Trustees.
- You will gain experience in general office management including supporting IT services, general office maintenance and health & safety.

The Process

Application is by completion of a short online application via our recruitment platform ([Applied](#)).

We are committed to fair and unbiased recruitment and use Applied to remove any unconscious bias from our process. You will be asked to answer a small set of questions that address the job description and person specification.

Candidates who successfully progress from the application stage will be invited to an interview.
