London Sport is tendering for community engagement on behalf of the Brent Physical Activity Partnership.

About London Sport

Our requirements

- The purpose of this Tender is to procure an agency for qualitative community engagement research across Brent.
- Community engagement will help the places to understand the barriers and challenges residents of Brent face in being physically active and the opportunities to support residents to increase their physical activity levels.
- The agency will produce a presentation and report containing themes and learnings from qualitative research for Brent, covering the barriers, opportunities, behaviours, and interventions local residents would be likely to use within their respective place around physical activity.
- The agency will be responsible for the methodology design and upskill the Brent Physical Activity Partnership in how to conduct qualitative community engagement research. The commissioned agency will be responsible for analysing the consultation findings and writing the research reports.

Candidates are asked to submit an application outlining how they meet the criteria as detailed in the Tender Specification. This is what the scoring matrix will be based on for the applications.
