Summary of Tender Specification

The purpose of the contract being tendered will be to provide:

- Design and deliver a 3-year *Political Systems Training Programme* to build the confidence and capability of community organisations, partners and London Sport staff to engage effectively with elected councillors and navigate political decision-making in local government across London.
- Develop accessible training materials and interactive workshops (minimum of 7 online sessions across the contract period).
- Facilitate learning, reflection, and application of knowledge in local contexts.
- Provide evaluation and reporting on participation, outcomes, and recommendations.

Contract value: Up to £36,000 (inclusive of VAT and expenses) over three years.

- Year 1 (Nov 2025 Mar 2026): £7,200
- Year 2 (Apr 2026 Mar 2027): £14,400
- Year 3 (Apr 2027 Mar 2028): £14,400
